June Biggs Kids Program at the Biggs Museum

Dover, DE – On Saturday, June 7, join the Museum for Biggs Kids, a free program for children ages 5-10 held on the first Saturday of every month. This program is designed to enrich children's understanding of art in the world around them. A segment of each program is devoted to teaching children about museums and the importance of museum etiquette. The program is open to the public and is held in the program gallery at the Museum from 2:00 to 3:30p.m. On Saturday, June 7, Children will learn about antique photographic processes including cyanotypes. After exploring Legislative Mall to find botanical specimens, the children will work with a special paper and sunlight to create photographic blueprints or cyanotypes.
