Biggs Kids and Mini-Masters: Photo Frames and More!

March 2009 Educational and Exhibition Programming For Children







Dover, DE – Please join the Biggs Museum at one of the several children's educational programs to be offered in March 2009. Each program entails an activity related to the *Biggs Shot 2009* Exhibition: a display of the selected works from the *Biggs Shot 2009* Photography Competition, featuring artists working or living in the Mid-Atlantic region.

Biggs Kids and Mini-Masters participants at the March programs will bring their favorite memories to life by decorating a picture frame to hold their treasured photograph. Participants are encouraged to bring a favorite 4X6 photograph for inspiration.

On Saturday, March 28th, from 2:00-3:00 p.m., the Biggs Museum will host a Photo Collage Workshop. This program is free to children ages 5-10. Each participant will create a collage using an enlarged photograph of themselves, their family, or a pet by layering paper, paint and photographs to create a work of art that tells a story. Preregistration is required for this program and can be completed by phone or in the *Biggs Kids* section on the Museum web-site. Participants are required to drop off a photograph to the Museum by Friday, March 27 at 2:00 p.m. so that Biggs staff can enlarge the image.

Biggs Kids and Mini-Masters are open to the public and are held in the program gallery at the Museum. Biggs Kids is held on the first Saturday of every month from 2:00 - 3:00 p.m. for children ages 5-10. Mini-Masters is held on the third Wednesday of every month from 1:00 - 2:00 p.m. for children ages 3-5. **Pre-registration is required** for both Mini-
